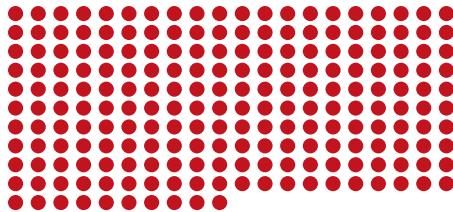
North Carolina lawmakers have **scheduled another round of tax cuts** for January 2019 that will **reduce annual revenue by nearly \$1 billion each fiscal year**. The corporate income tax rate will drop to 2.5% which is down from 6.9% in 2013.

NC lawmakers can STOP scheduled tax cuts this legislative session.

\$1 billion would go a long way to meet national standards of specialized school personnel to support children's education success and healthy development. Revisiting our failed 2013 tax-cut experiment since 2013 could *make even more revenue available for priorities that benefit our children, families and communities.*

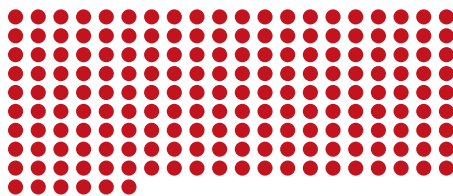
